

Cookies – what are they?

A cookie is a piece of data (alphanumeric identifier text file) stored by a website within a browser, and then subsequently sent back to the same website by the browser. Cookies were designed to be a reliable mechanism for websites to remember things that a browser had done there in the past, which can include having clicked particular buttons, logging in, or having visited certain pages. This will speed up your browser access when viewing any area of our site. This is a normal process when you visit web sites.

Cookies cannot carry viruses. They are used to perform essential functions on our website. Removing them could impact your experience when using websites.
